Application Criteria & Instructions

After WO2 Alfred Wong passed away as the result of an accident in June 2007, his family and friends generously donated funds for a scholarship to be awarded annually in memory of this exceptional young man and outstanding Air Cadet. In recognition of Alfred's interest in music, the scholarship is given to an Air Cadet who has shown commitment to the music program and / or is pursuing a post-secondary program with some focus on music.

The scholarship is to be awarded by competition, on a merit basis, to a serving or retiring Air Cadet who fulfills one of the two following mandatory criteria:

1. Enrolling in a post-secondary program with some focus on music; OR
2. Enrolling in a post-secondary program, and has participated in the Air Cadet Band program for at least three years (not necessarily consecutive years).

And further, that they can also demonstrate the following requirements:

- Good academic standing at secondary school
- A good record of community involvement
- A good record of participation in Squadron activities
- Completed at least four years' service as an Air Cadet

The application must be supported by the following documentation:

1. A letter from the applicant (250-300 words), describing their interest in either (a) a music-related area of study and providing an outline of their career goals; or (b) the value that their involvement in the Air Cadet music program has given to them.
2. A one-page summary of the applicant's Cadet career; extra-curricular school activities; and community activities (point-form is sufficient).
3. A letter from recommendation from the applicant's Squadron Commanding Officer, identifying the applicant's dates of involvement in the Air Cadet music program.
4. A letter of support from the Chairman of the Sponsoring Committee of the applicant's Squadron.
5. A letter of recommendation from the applicant's school principal, music teacher or counsellor.
6. A copy of the most recently available transcript of secondary school marks.

The value of the scholarship will be \$1,200.00 annually. Applications will be reviewed and a recipient selected by the OPC Honours & Awards Committee, whose decision is final. Award of the scholarship will not receive final approval until proof of registration at a university or college has been received. (Proof of acceptance is sufficient at the time of application).

The successful applicant will be announced on the OPC website and a representative of the Wong family will present the recipient with their scholarship at the Cadet Awards Luncheon held in conjunction with the OPC Annual Conference each fall. (The actual funds can be advanced earlier, if required).

Completed applications must be received at the OPC Office not later than August 31.
